## EXHIBIT RULES

1. All entries must be **ORIGINAL** (no licensed characters, kits, preformed ceramics, etc.) and created within the past two years. Work created in high school but exhibited after graduation may be entered in the high school division, as long as it meets all other requirements.
2. Entries are limited to no more than four 2-D and four 3-D per person.
3. All entries meant to be hung must be finished with screw eyes and wire for hanging. Grade School entries only, may be framed OR matted and mounted on foamcore or matboard ( Do NOT use poster board or construction paper) with some type hanging device. (Do not tape a string to the back) Frames with easel backs are fine.
5. The committee has the right to reclassify or reject any art work that does not meet the requirements.
6. Grundy County residency is not required.
7. Reasonable care will be taken with the art work, but we cannot accept responsibility for damage or loss.
8. **Do not ask or expect the librarians to accept, check-in or release any art work. If you have any questions call the Corn Festival office or Ms. Miller, do NOT call the library.**
