

2011 Grundy County Corn Festival Art Show

Held at the **Morris Area Library**

Entries accepted : Tuesday, Sept. 27 from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m.

Entry Fee : Corn Festival Button

Open to the public : Thursday, Friday & Saturday, Sept. 29, 30 & Oct. 1 **During Library hours**

EXHIBIT RULES

1. All entries must be **ORIGINAL** (no licensed characters, kits, preformed ceramics, etc.), created within the past two years and not shown in the Corn Festival Art Show before.
2. Entries are limited to no more than **four 2-D** and **four 3-D** per person.
3. All Adult pieces meant to be hung must be framed or canvas edges finished **and ready to hang with picture wire**. Acrylic glazing is preferred to glass for framed pieces.
We cannot hang pieces without a hanging wire, nor can we hang extremely large pieces.
- High School and Youth 2-D pieces that are not framed, must be **matted AND mounted** on mat board or foam board, with some type of secure hanging device.
(Do not use poster board or construction paper for mounting, Do not tape a string to the back)
4. Securely attach to each piece an index card with the following information:
Name, Phone #, Division, Section, Class, and title or description of work.
Also, on adult items, whether or not the piece is for sale (FS or NFS).
5. All entries **MUST** be picked up on **MONDAY** after Corn Festival between 4 and 6 P.M.
Any pieces not picked up by Friday after Corn Festival will be **forfeited**.
6. The committee has the right to reclassify or reject any art work that does not meet the requirements.
7. Grundy County residency is not required.
8. Reasonable care will be taken with the art work, but we cannot accept responsibility for damage or loss.
