CORN, GRAIN AND FLOWER SHOW RULES

1. All exhibits must be in place not later than 10:00 a.m. Saturday. Entries in Section 8 to 12 can be placed Friday evening.
2. Competition is open to all amateur growers.
3. All exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor. The only exception is wild flowers, weeds and dried bouquet, and corn in 301 and 302.
4. Each exhibitor must furnish his own containers and have them arranged for exhibit before admitted.
5. Exhibitors are required to name all varieties as far as possible.
6. Not responsible for loss or breakage of any plant or article.
7. Judging will be between 10 a.m. and Noon Saturday. The Corn and Flower Show will be open from 12 to 7 p.m.
8. Exhibits can be removed after the Sunday Parade and must be removed by 5 p.m. Sunday.
9. Ribbons to all entries will be awarded first, second and third. Also section sweepstakes and grand sweepstakes. There may be more than sectional sweepstakes in Section 5.
10. Each exhibitor is allowed one entry in any class, except class 102, 112 and 122.
11. In case of a lot of entries in the following classes, 100, 102, 112, 122, or 142 the class or classes may be divided and ribbons awarded in each division. The manner of dividing the class shall be at the discretion of the judge.
